The Minister of Small and Medium-sized Enterprises, Social Economy and Handicrafts hereby informs stakeholders in the entrepreneurial ecosystem residing in Cameroon that a call for applications has been launched for their benefit for the admission of forty (40) first-time entrepreneurs to the acceleration programme of the National Pilot Business Incubator in Edéa, with a view to scaling up their businesses.

The selected entrepreneurs will complete a 20-week work-study programme focused on technological and/or organisational innovation.

I. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible, entrepreneurs must:

- Hold at least a BEPC or equivalent diploma, or provide proof of validation of acquired experience (VAE);
- Demonstrate dynamism, agility and selflessness;
- Be willing to attend classes in situ at the NPEN;
- Be able to read and write at least one of the two official languages;
- Be at least 18 years of age on 1 January 2025;
- Have been through an incubator approved by the MINPMEESA (preferential criterion);
- Have presented an innovative business creation project with strong economic potential in the following priority sectors: Agro-industry (processing of agricultural and pastoral products and mechanisation), wood and nontimber forest products (bamboo, rattan and straw), cotton, leather, textile, digital technology, etc.
- Have a laptop computer;
- Female applicants are strongly encouraged (preferential criterion);

For applicants who have already started their own business, the business must:

Have been legally established for less than three years;

- Operate primarily in the above-mentioned sectors;
- > Be registered in the national SME Data File (preferential criterion);
- Have the relevant financial statements (preferential criterion).
